

“Grandes Eaux Nocturnes du Château de Versailles (‘Fountains Night Shows’) 2019” Competition Rules

ARTICLE 1: SUBJECT

Air Liquide S.A., registered with the Paris RCS under number 552 096 281 and with corporate headquarters located at 75 Quai d’Orsay 75007 Paris, has organised a free competition with no obligation to purchase called "Air Liquide Competition – Versailles 2019".

In these rules the Organizing Body will hereafter be referred to as Air Liquide S.A.

ARTICLE 2: PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

The competition is free and open to both residents and non-residents of France. There is no obligation to purchase, and a limit of ONE (1) entry per person.

Members of the organisational team are not permitted to enter the competition.

ARTICLE 3: RULES OF PARTICIPATION

Channels for participation:

The competition is only available online. It can be accessed via the ‘Shareholders’ section of the www.airliquide.com website (versions available in French and English) or by clicking directly on the links below:

Entries submitted by any other method, especially via post, telephone or email, will be ignored.

Participation:

Participants will have to respond to FOUR (4) multiple choice questions. As part of their entry, each participant will need to:

- Provide (*) postcode, their contact details, specifically their title, surname, first name and full address (address, city and country) as well as their email address and telephone number.
() It is compulsory to provide this information as winners are informed both electronically and by telephone. Neither Air Liquide S.A. nor its contractors will be held responsible for details that are inaccurate, incomplete or illegible.*
- Accept these rules.

1 Eligibility to enter the prize draw:

Eligibility to enter the prize draw will be established as follows: participants must correctly answer FOUR(4) of the FOUR (4) questions asked.

In the event that not enough participants answer at least FOUR (4) of the questions correctly, participants who answered THREE (3) question correctly may become eligible.

Exclusion of participants:

Participants who do not answer any questions correctly will be declared ineligible for entry into the prize draw.

Air Liquide S.A. reserves the right to, without prior notice:

- disqualify any participants who create multiple e-mail addresses using the same name and address;
- reject entries which are incomplete, false, or made in contravention of these rules;
- exclude any participants who disrupt the smooth running of the competition.

ARTICLE 4. SCHEDULE

The competition will be open from wednesday 15th May 2019 to Sathurday 15th June 2019, midnight.

The draw to select the winners will be on or after 21 th June 2019, and will be supervised by a legal officer.

The winners will be informed by e-mail or by phone (see Art.6) within the TEN (10) days following the draw.

The dates and times used in these competition rules are those of Paris (France).

ARTICLE 5. THE PRIZES

5.1. Prizes:

The prizes offered in this prize draw are as follows:

1 st prize: ONE (1) 'Versailles Spectacles' gift set (worth EUR 427€) including:

- 4 places for the Grandes Eaux Musicales ('Musical Fountains Shows'), valid for 2019
- A fine book on the Fountains of Versailles
- A compilation CD of the music accompanying les Grands Eaux de Versailles
- 4 seats for the Grandes Eaux Nocturnes, valid for the 2019 season
- 2 first selection seats to the Marie Antoinette firework display in Group F in the Jardins de l'Orangerie (5 dates: 4.5.11 and 12th of July 2019 from 10pm)

Prizes 2 to 11: (worth EUR 88)

2 prestige tickets for ONE person (parking place + 1 glass of champagne) undated for the Grandes Eaux Nocturnes and valid any Saturday of your choice between 15 th June and 21 th September from 20:30 to 23:05.

Prizes 12 to 1051: (worth €52)

- 2 tickets for ONE (1) person to the Grandes Eaux Nocturnes du Château de Versailles. Ticket valid for any Saturday of your choice between 15 th June and 21 th September 2019 from 20:30 to 23:05.

Transport, meals and accommodation are at the winner's expense.

The prizes offered shall not give rise, on the part of the winners, to any dispute of any kind, nor to financial payment of their value in lieu in any form whatsoever, nor their replacement or exchange.

The tickets are not named, so they can be offered to anyone free of charge under the sole condition that the winner is unable to attend the show.

In the event of the death of a participant, the award of the prize will be permanently cancelled, without indemnity or compensation of any kind for their heirs.

The prize thus released will be reallocated through a draw in the form and under conditions identical to those previously stipulated.

In a case of force majeure (Act of God) or if circumstances require, Air Liquide S.A. shall reserve the right to substitute specific prizes with prizes of equal or greater value.

5.2. Only one entry per individual

The number of entries per individual is limited to ONE (1).

5.3. Delivery of prizes

Prizes will be sent to the winners by post to the address indicated on the entry form. Prizes returned by the postal service for any reason, particularly UATA (unknown at this address) will be declared abandoned and will not be returned to the draw. They will not be the subject of any form of compensation.

Air Liquide S.A. shall not be held responsible for any prize that is damaged on delivery.

3 ARTICLE 6. DESIGNATION OF WINNERS

The 1,051 winners will be selected by a draw, carried out under the supervision of a legal officer, from all duly eligible participants under Article 3 of these Game Rules.

The prizes will be attributed in chronological order of drawing from the 1 st to the 1,051 st prize.

The winners will be informed by email for prizes 12 to 1,051 and by telephone for 1st and 2-11 prizes. Neither Air Liquide S.A. nor its contractors shall be held liable for non-delivery of an email. You are reminded that the email or phone number used will be those shown on the entry form. In the event of a dispute, only the lists on the competition site are considered binding.

ARTICLE 7. DATA PROTECTION

All participants acknowledge that they have been notified that the gathering of personal information is required for their participation in the game. Nominative information gathered will be collected by Air Liquide S.A. –75 Quai d’Orsay 75007 Paris – with a view towards organising other games or competitions and their processing is required to take part in the draw. This information will be used by the Air Liquide Shareholder Department for organising games and will not be shared with third parties. It may be used by the Air Liquide Shareholder Department as part of its effort to collect information on the current and prospective shareholders of Air Liquide S.A. and may be preserved for three (3) years counting from their gathering or the last contact with the participant.

In accordance with the law applicable to the protection of personal data, and in particular to the law No. 78-17 of 6 January 1978 amended relating to information technology, files and freedoms, the participants enjoy a right of access, of rectification, erasure, portability on the data concerning them and the right to the limitation of processing for the reasons described by the law. ARTICLE 8: REIMBURSEMENT

Connection fees paid to enter the game and view the rules may be reimbursed on the basis of TWO (2) minutes (domestic minutes at the current Orange tariff) for participants on Pay-As-You-Go (PAYG) plans. Participants without PAYG plans (e.g. who use a flat-rate subscription instead) will not be entitled to any reimbursement.

4 Postage costs incurred for the sending of claim forms or reimbursement requests pursuant to this article will be reimbursed in kind with a ‘La Poste’ ECOPLI stamp valid for objects weighing less than 20 g. You are reminded that Air Liquide S.A. provides a Freepost address which you may use in the event of a request.

One single reimbursement request will be taken into account per individual. Consequently, requests for connection and postage reimbursements will need to be made as part of the same request. In the event of multiple requests being submitted by the same individual, only the first will be taken into account.

Reimbursement requests must:

- clearly indicate the participant’s first name, last name, and complete address;
- describe the nature and purpose of the costs for which reimbursement is required;
- specify the date and time at which the competition was entered;
- be accompanied by a copy of the invoice showing the connection charges incurred (Internet) for the period in question;

Air Liquide S.A. will not be held responsible for costs incurred in the event of an invalid entry.

ARTICLE 9. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CURRENT RULES

Participants confirm that they acknowledge these rules and agree to comply with all provisions. Participation in the competition implies unconditional acceptance of these rules.

ARTICLE 10. LIABILITY/FORCE MAJEURE/EXTENSIONS/APPENDICES

Online participation in the competition implies understanding and acceptance of the characteristics and the limits of the online technologies used, and all related technologies.

Air Liquide S.A. does not guarantee that the operation of the game site will be uninterrupted or error free, nor that it will be compatible with all browsers and computing environments.
