
FLYING WHALES

Waga Energy is an Air Liquide spin-off whose aim is to transform landfill biogas into clean, local, renewable and competitive energy. Waga Energy's biomethane can be injected into the grid or used as a vehicle fuel.

Diabeloop, based in Grenoble, France, developing an artificial pancreas to improve the treatment of patients with type 1 diabetes. Diabeloop's technology has been evaluated in clinical trials at the hospital and, in the joint laboratory with CEA-Leti, with patients at home.
