## Air Liquide: 2014 Free Share Allocation

Following the one for ten **free share allocation** on June 2, 2014 decided by Air Liquide Board of Directors, shareholders whose number of shares cannot be divided by 10 are entitled to "fractional rights".

The unit price allocated for fractional rights amounts to:

- 9.88 Euros per fractional right following the allocation of one free share for every 10 existing shares,
- **0.99 Euros** per fractional right, for the 10% loyalty bonus for shares held in registered form continuously from December 31, 2011 to June 1, 2014 included.

Shareholders will be paid the amount of their fractional rights on July 2, 2014.
