

Changes to payment methods

With a focus on **modernization** and **enhanced security**, the payment methods for share purchase orders made via the **Air Liquide Shareholder Portal** are evolving as of **January 1, 2026**.



PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD: the ideal solution for share purchase orders of up to €10,000

This payment method is available regardless of whether you already hold Air Liquide shares in your portfolio.

It is the simplest, fastest, and most efficient solution for purchases below €10,000.

- ▶ Limit: €10,000 per order.
- ▶ How it works:
 - ↳ **"Market price" or "best price"**: if a pre-authorization of 105% of the estimated amount is required, only the exact final amount is debited after execution of the purchase order.
 - ↳ **"Limit price"**: a pre-authorization of 100% of the amount is required. The debit takes place after execution of the order.



BANK TRANSFER in detail

You may also opt for payment by bank transfer, depending on your specific situation.

End of SEPA direct debit

For enhanced security reasons, payment by SEPA direct debit is no longer available.

(*) In accordance with the French Monetary and Financial Code and the general terms and conditions applicable to the Air Liquide securities account, ownership of financial securities is acquired only after full settlement of the transaction. Any failure to pay will result in the immediate resale of the securities. For any subsequent purchase, funds will systematically be required from the account holder prior to execution.
